Nottingham City Council, Nottinghamshire County Council, and NHS Nottingham and Nottinghamshire CCG have recently co-produced a (draft) joint <u>Carers Strategy</u> with local carers and carer support organisations.

Unpaid carers support services across Nottinghamshire and Nottingham City

As partner organisations we are now working together to review and re-commission services which support unpaid carers of all ages, across Nottingham and Nottinghamshire.

This includes:

- Raising awareness of unpaid carers and enabling them to access support earlier
- Providing information, advice, and guidance
- Providing individual and group support for carers (including young carers)
- Providing breaks from the caring role

To inform and shape the new services that we will commission, we are seeking the views of partners across Health, Social Care, unpaid carers, carer support organisations and other community partners.
